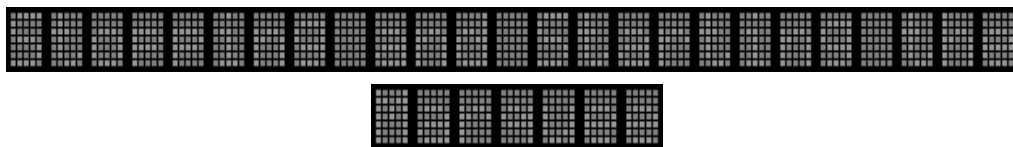
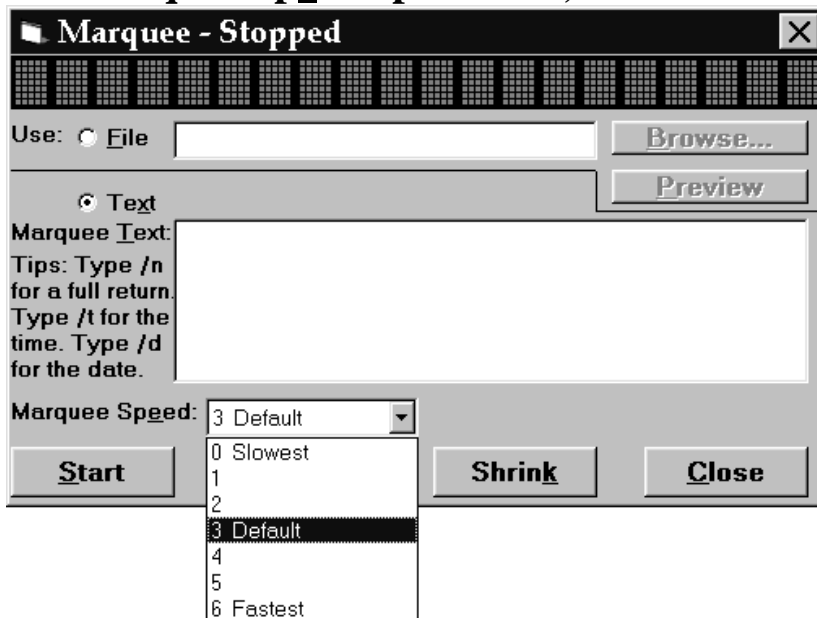
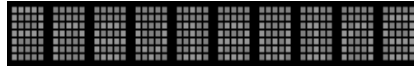


To change the speed of the marquee from the default 3, click the Marquee Speed option box, and select a value:

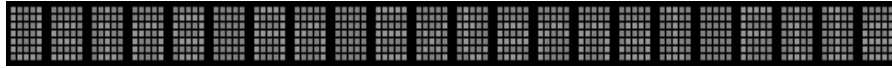


To start the Marquee, click the Start button. This disables everything but the speed box, the Stop button, the Shrink button, and the Close button. To stop the Marquee, click the Stop button. This re-enables all controls. If you try to run Marquee in external file mode with no file loaded, the Start button will be disabled.

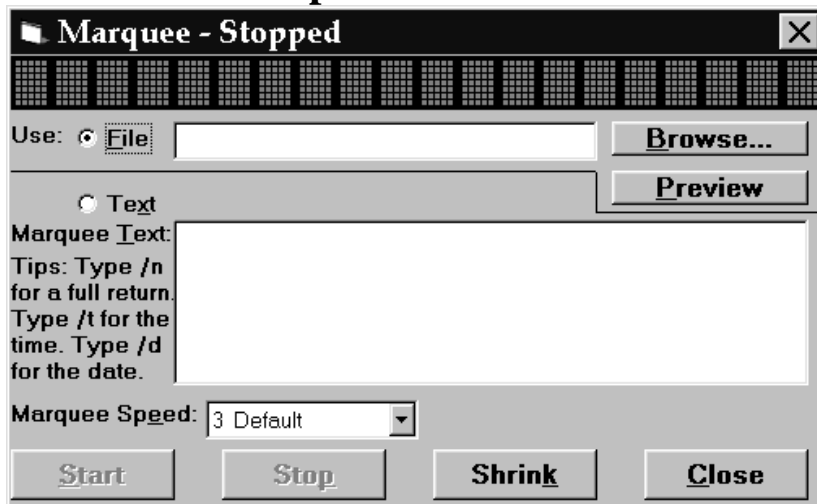


You can also preview a file before scrolling it by hitting the Preview button, below the Browse button. This brings up a window like this:

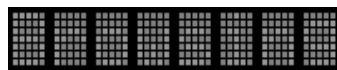




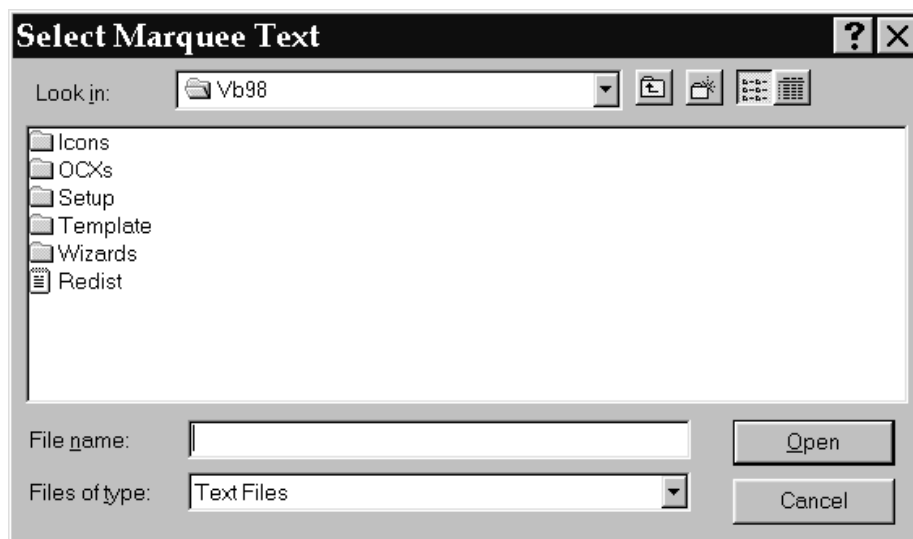
You can also tell Marquee to read from an external file for the marquee text. This updates the scrolling text with every scroll. Below is the setup for an external file:

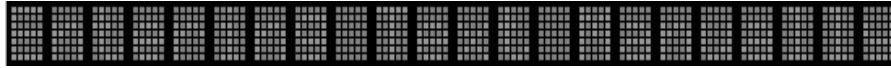


The next two sections will describe how to use the external file function.

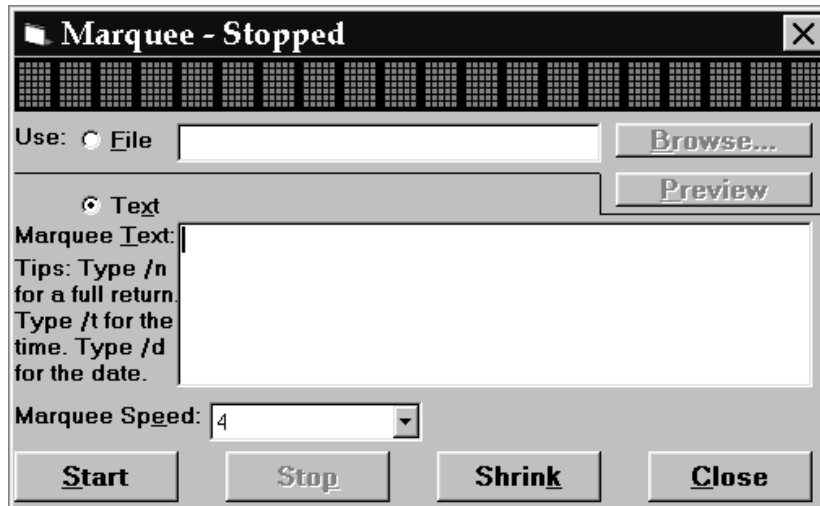


In order to tell Marquee which file to use, you use the Browse... button next to the text box. It brings up a dialog box like this:





The picture below shows the basic setup of Marquee:
To manually enter your own text in, click inside the Marquee

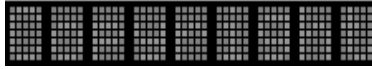


Text box. You can enter in as many characters as you want. If you want a full return (scrolling doesn't continue until the Marquee is blank), type the /n character. To put the time in, type /t. To put the date in, type /d. The time and date are updated with every scroll.

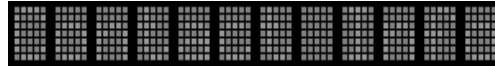

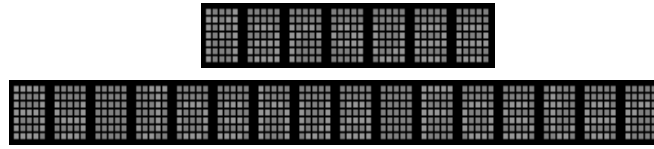
